
S P E C I A L M E E T I N G

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The certification of the mill levy is a requirement of municipalities, special districts, etc. each year. The County Assessor has until December 10th to provide the final certification of valuation to those entities. The City (and those other entities) is required to turn around the mill levy certification to the County by December 15th each year.
- The final certification of valuation has not yet been received, but is expected on Monday, December 8, 2014. Consequently, the resolution will be prepared thereafter and provided to Council at the special meeting on December 9th.
