Resolution establishing a public hearing process for matters involving the adoption of Water Conservation Plans. City Attorney Beatty explained that the intent of the resolution is to establish a public hearing process for matters involving adoption of Water Conservation Plans and to establish a slightly more compressed time for public review and comment than what would otherwise be required pursuant to regulations for the adoption of water conservation plans. This resolution would adopt a 30 day public review process whereby a copy of the draft conservation plan are available at City Hall and on the City's website for review and comments by residents and property owners of the City and water utility customers. A motion to adopt the resolution was made by Councilmember Bolton and seconded by Councilmember Shew. Upon roll call vote the motion carried unanimously. The resolution was adopted.
